General Information

Aims: To provide clinically relevant information about Clinical Nutrition; to enable participants to start a Clinical Nutrition programme back in their workplace.

Learning objectives: Main areas to be covered are: nutritional assessment, prevention and treatment of malnutrition, techniques, control and complications of nutritional support, nutrition in different pathologies: critically ill, sepsis, single and multiple organ failure, gastrointestinal disorders, cardiac, lung and kidney failure and many other clinical practice topics.

The course will be held as morning plenary lectures and afternoon group-working practical demonstrations and case-based problem-solving discussions; each clinical case will be plenary debated during the next morning by the students together with the tutors.

Accommodation: all rooms are equipped with bathroom and TV. We ask that you return the key to the reception when you are not in. All extra charges will be credited to your personal account. ESPEN is bearing the cost of your stay for 5 nights, starting from Friday, 15th of October.
